2025 Scholarship Announcement and Application Application Deadline: March 15, 2025

The National Association of Buffalo Soldiers and Troopers Motorcycle Club[™] Michigan chapter (NABSTMC[™]) is pleased to announce the chapter's 2025 scholarship program. Scholarships up to \$1,000 will be awarded to graduating high school seniors to aid in their educational pursuits at a college, university, or trade school of their choice. We invite you to apply!

To qualify for a scholarship, you must be an eligible graduating high school senior/GED recipient during the 2024-2025 school year who will enter college or vocational/trade school in 2025. Applicants must submit a completed application packet to include the following:

- 1. A completed Application Form and signed Check-List. Parent/Guardian signature required for applicants under age 18.
- 2. A Letter of Introduction explaining who you are and your achievements (typed).
- 3. A 500-word minimum written response on one of the essay topics provided (typed).
- 4. A copy of your high school transcript (unofficial transcripts are acceptable) or home school transcript, which verifies a <u>2.0 grade point average or higher</u>. GED Certificate may be provided instead of transcript if applicable.
- 5. One (1) letter of recommendation on official letterhead from a teacher, school counselor, school administrator or employer (for GED candidates).
- 6. One (1) letter of recommendation on letterhead from a community service organization.
- 7. One (1) letter of acceptance to an institution of higher learning. (if available)
- 8. A recent professional looking head shot (preferably in Cap and Gown).

All applications must be delivered via email by midnight on <u>March 15, 2025</u>. Please submit completed application and essays as **PDF** files. Headshots should be attached as JPEG, GIF, or PNG image files. Email to <u>scholarships@buffalosoldiersmi.com</u>.

- How will this scholarship help you? What is your financial need? Are there any extenuating circumstances?
- What are your future educational and career aspirations? How do you plan to give back to your community?
- Is there anything else you would like us to know or consider?

Essay 2: Original Buffalo Soldiers History and Legacy- Research and write a 500-word essay demonstrating what you know about the legacy of the <u>original</u> Buffalo Soldiers and their contributions to American history. Do not write about the National Association of Buffalo Soldiers and Troopers Motorcycle Club[™]. Note: Please submit your own work. Essays will be checked for plagiarism. <u>Essays with plagiarism and essays less than 500 words will disqualify your application</u>. Select one of the topics below:

- Topic 1- What impact did the original Buffalo Soldiers make in war and/or peacetime? How does the original Buffalo Soldier legacy inspire you and why is it important to share this legacy with future generations?
- Topic 2- Provide specific examples of how the original Buffalo Soldiers helped with the development of roadways, national parks, and mail service. Discuss specific original Buffalo Soldiers who distinguished themselves in any of these areas.
- Topic 3- The Congressional Medal of Honor is the United States Armed Forces highest and most prestigious military decoration that may be awarded to recognize American service men and women who have distinguished themselves by acts of valor. Please provide a narrative regarding a original Buffalo Soldier that received this honor and what can be learned from their life, efforts and commitment to duty.

Attach one (1) LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION on letterhead from a community service organization.

Attach One (1) LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE to an institution of higher learning. (if available)

Attach a current unofficial high school TRANSCRIPT or provide GED Certificate if applicable.

PLEASE NOTE

Consideration will be given only to candidates submitting **complete** application packets including a signed Check-List. If selected, the award will be submitted to the student for use towards school costs and expenses. Awards will be made only upon presentation of proof of enrollment at an accredited community college, four-year college or university, or trade school. **Awards will be made on a one-time basis**. Awardees may be selected for consideration for additional scholarships at the Frontier and National level of the NABSTMC[™].
